

#### **ANNUAL CHRISTMAS CANTATA**


Come join us in this new musical celebration of the message of Christmas, as well as our Candlelight Service and Reception in conclusion.

There are many reasons why and it began with my falls and fractured rib, John having 2 procedures at the hospital that is very tiring to go and stay, and them home again, packing and preparing to leave for a period of time, making plane reservations, calling transport company to pick up car and take to Fl. other doctor appointments and my cousin coming to visit for 5 days-like each one of you have with life obligations.

I thought plans were going fine until Daughter Amy came to see us and say good-by the day before we were leaving. She asked if I had checked in for the flight tomorrow and I told her I was having trouble with it. She said she would do it for me. "Mom, I cannot find any reservation for you on this flight".

I remember very well of the dates to leave and April to return, picked out seats, but evidently did not finish it or something. She spent over 1 hour, finally found 4 seats available and bought 2, the woman kept misspelling John's name, which must be spelled correctly to match passports, and I paced and prayed. Arriving at the airport and at check-in, they found John's name still misspelled, but the woman knew how to change it and off we went to where we go to the plane. Leah and Ashley pushed our wheelchairs like experts and one (without us saying a word) went to the attendant and asked if we could sit together and closer to the front. They truly took great care of us.

When the plane took off, I closed my eyes for the entire trip and rested and praised and thanks Father for His great mercy and help in our time of need. Praise His Holy Name.
