Psalm 127 is a Psalm that speaks of reliance on God for the things of life.

- The building of the house
- The guarding of the city
- The work you labor at
- The raising of children

The point of the psalm is not that you can just forsake your responsibility in these things, but you need to perform these duties with a relationship and a reliance on the Lord God of Heaven.

The Psalmist states that to do otherwise is to do these things in vain.

The part of this psalm that has been running through my brain these past few weeks is the last portion of verse 2, "For He gives to His beloved even in his sleep."

There is a lot of comfort in those few words.

"He gives..." God takes an interest in me

"His beloved..." I love the tenderness of this word referring to me "even in his sleep" I don't always have to be on point, struggling, worrying, fighting. I can trust and rest in Him.

Do you feel this closeness to the Father?

If you have accepted Christ as your Savior, then you also are one of His beloved saints.

John writes in 1 John 3:21, "Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence before God."

Draw near to the Father right now. Jesus sacrificed Himself for your sins that you could have access to the Holy throne of God. Don't keep trying to do it all on your own. Trust in Him and Rest in Him.



Let us lay aside petty disagreements and attitudes and plunge into His kindness and joy for each of His children.




